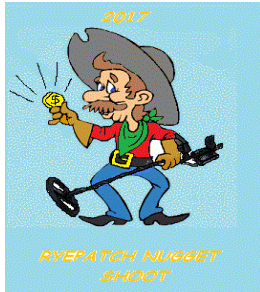


2017 Rye Patch Nugget Shoot

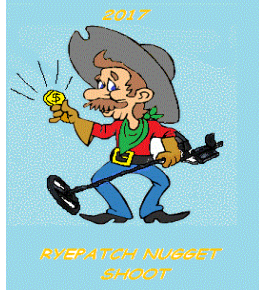
