

## Claims and usage of claims

Members must be classified as in “good standing”, to be classified as a member in “good standing” the member must have attended 4 meetings within the last 12 months in order to access, mine or prospect any of GPAA of Northern Nevada Reno “GNNR” claims. A \$10.00 dollar fee is required for each claim a member in good standing wishes to access. The annual 12 month meeting requirement of 4 meetings within the last 12 month period must be maintained to remain a member in good standing. All members will be required to possess and display, upon request, their membership identification information for official inspection by an agent or member of management of GPAA of Northern Nevada Reno “GNNR”. Persons mining or prospecting on GPAA of Northern Nevada Reno “GNNR” claims without the required identification may forfeit their access to GPAA of Northern Nevada Reno “GNNR” claims as determined by GPAA of Northern Nevada Reno “GNNR” management. Members will maintain proper conduct and observe all GPAA of Northern Nevada Reno “GNNR” rules, all local, State and Federal laws and regulations. All members will be required to report any potential and actual dangers to GPAA of Northern Nevada Reno “GNNR” management and/or the proper authorities immediately upon discovery of the danger. Mining is dangerous and members understand the dangers associated with mining activity, camping, hiking and accessing public lands. GPAA of Northern Nevada Reno “GNNR” will not be held liable for accidents and injuries sustained by accessing, using, mining, prospecting or any other activities on these public lands and GPAA of Northern Nevada Reno “GNNR” claims. Each member is responsible for the safety and well-being of themselves, their family, guests and other persons who may be using the claims while they are there. GPAA of Northern Nevada Reno “GNNR” claims will be used for individual and group prospecting activities. No member may prospect in any areas designated as off limits that are so marked or so noted in the claim description. GPAA of Northern Nevada Reno “GNNR” requires all members to back fill any holes you or guests dig prior to leaving the area so as to eliminate the potential dangers associated with these activities. No member shall transfer, sell, convey or loan their membership to another person at any time. All gold found by members shall be for the members to keep. Special group prospecting events will be scheduled for GPAA of Northern Nevada Reno “GNNR” members and guests and will be conducted by the management of GPAA of Northern Nevada Reno “GNNR” Any disputes and violations will be handled by GPAA of Northern Nevada Reno “GNNR” management. GPAA of Northern Nevada Reno “GNNR” management decisions on matters of membership and claims access shall be considered final, including sanctions and expulsion of members from the claim and GPAA of Northern Nevada Reno “GNNR”. Littering of any kind on any GPAA of Northern Nevada Reno “GNNR” claims will

not be tolerated and is grounds for immediate expulsion from all GPAA of Northern Nevada Reno "GNNR" lands and claims. Members and guests are solely responsible for the proper disposal and removal of their debris, garbage, pet feces, and any other item deemed "litter". GPAA of Northern Nevada Reno "GNNR" has a strict policy of "pack it in, pack it out". If/when any claims of GPAA of Northern Nevada Reno "GNNR" terminates or the owner loses their access for violations, the member will be notified by GPAA of Northern Nevada Reno "GNNR" via its website at [www.gpaaofnorthernnevadareno.com](http://www.gpaaofnorthernnevadareno.com). When new or alternative claims become available, the members will be notified on GPAA of Northern Nevada Reno "GNNR" website at [www.gpaaofnorthernnevadareno.com](http://www.gpaaofnorthernnevadareno.com). Family pets must be kept in control and all applicable laws in regards to leashes (if required) are to be followed. Any injuries any person may receive as a result of a pet will be the liability of the pet owner and not GPAA of Northern Nevada Reno "GNNR". Camp fires are only permitted if the member has a valid campfire permit if required. All campfires are to be properly and completely extinguished upon leaving any camp site for any reason. Members are required to report any violations of these rules to management of GPAA of Northern Nevada Reno "GNNR" upon discovery. GPAA of Northern Nevada Reno "GNNR" claims are on public lands and are not owned by GPAA of Northern Nevada Reno "GNNR", do not interfere or harass any other member of the public on any of the GPAA of Northern Nevada Reno "GNNR" claims. If a non-member is mining or prospecting on one of GPAA of Northern Nevada Reno "GNNR", notify GPAA of Northern Nevada Reno "GNNR" management immediately. Obtain their license plate (if available) and do not engage in a dispute. No commercial equipment shall be allowed on any GPAA of Northern Nevada Reno "GNNR" claims. The rules and regulations, terms and conditions may be altered, modified and updated at any time by GPAA of Northern Nevada Reno "GNNR"
